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## Preventive Dental Care

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- I. **The client/caregiver can state purpose of good oral hygiene.**
  - A. To provide comfort
  - B. To decrease unpleasant tastes and odors
  - C. To decrease the possibility of irritation, infection, or disease in mouth
  - D. To prevent cavities and gum disease
  
- II. **The client/caregiver can list measures to assure good dental/oral health.**
  - A. Brush teeth at least twice a day with fluoride toothpaste.
  - B. Floss teeth daily.
  - C. Eat snack smart—limit sugary or sticky snacks.
  - D. Get enough calcium in diet to support the health of teeth.
  - E. Do not smoke or use tobacco products.
  - F. Have regular dental exams.
  
- III. **The client/caregiver can demonstrate the correct method for brushing teeth.**
  - A. Use a soft-bristled toothbrush.
  - B. Hold toothbrush at slight angle against teeth, and use short back and forth motions.
  - C. Brush inside and chewing surfaces of teeth.
  - D. Brush your tongue.
  - E. Brush your teeth for about 2 minutes each time.
  - F. Rinse mouth well.
  
- IV. **The client/caregiver can demonstrate proper method for flossing.**
  - A. After brushing teeth, wrap approximately 18 inches of floss around your middle fingers.

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- B. Slide floss between teeth until it reaches the gum.
  - C. Pull floss against tooth and gum to remove plaque.
  - D. Floss each tooth several times using fresh floss as needed.
  - E. If there is a problem handling the floss, try a manufactured floss holder.
  - F. Rinse mouth well.
  
- V. **The client/caregiver can demonstrate care of dentures.**
  - A. Remove dentures, and place in a denture container.
  - B. Place a washcloth over the sink to prevent breaking if they are dropped.
  - C. Use tepid water because hot water may change the shape of some dentures.
  - D. If removing dentures during the night, place in covered denture container with water.
  - E. Have dentures adjusted as needed for proper fit.
